- Ensure their child comes to school every day, on time and prepared for learning.
- Ensure their child attends school in term time unless they are ill.
- Ensure their child is wearing clothing in line with school uniform recommendations and that their PE kit is in school on PE days.
- Collect their child punctually and advise the school if they are going to be late or if there is a change to the pick-up arrangements.
- Inform the school of any issues which might affect their child's learning or behaviour.
- Encourage good behaviour, politeness, self-respect and respect for others and their property.
- Encourage their child's learning in all areas of life and support them with their home learning.
- Support school values and ways of working.
- Be available to have a meeting with adults in school about any challenges in learning and behaviour.
- Attend parents' meetings and support school activities wherever possible.
- Ensure their child uses the internet safely and has a responsible attitude towards online activity, in partnership with the school.
- Make direct contact with the school to raise any concerns and remain supportive of the school on social media sites.

- Show kindness, consideration and respect to all.
- Be ready and willing to learn and do my best.
- Listen to others and follow instructions.
- Carry out my daily reading and home learning each week.
- Speak politely and be honest.
- Come to school on time every day.
