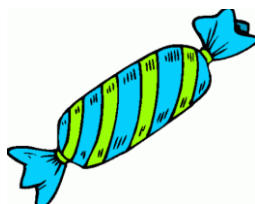
SEND Cuppa and Chat - Friday 28th November at 9am

- Aim to arrive allowing yourself plenty of time!

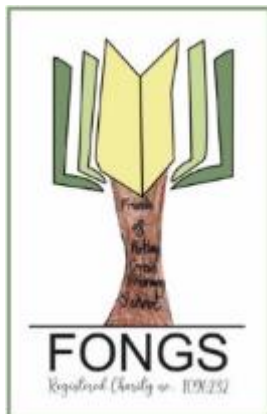
