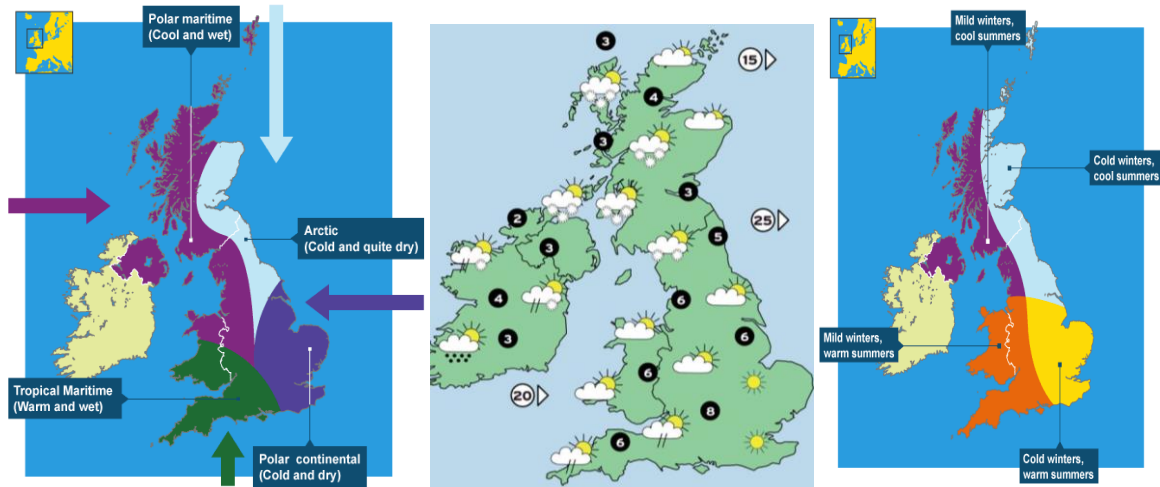

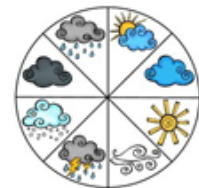
- Where is the UK on the world map?

### Key Definitions

weather forecast - a statement of what weather is likely to be for the next few days  
climate - the weather condition in an area over a long period of time

weather - the condition of the atmosphere at a particular time and place

degrees Celsius - unit of temperature
